

DEATH AND HELL ARE SPIRITS

YAHWEH:

Seersgate, what happens at death?

SEERSGATE:

When a person dies, the spirit and soul leave the flesh (body) and go to either Heaven or Hell.

(6) So we are always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. (7) For we walk by faith, not by sight. (8) We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord.

—2 Corinthians 5:6-8 NKJV

(28) Then Moses said, "By this you shall know that the Lord has sent me to do all these deeds; for it is not my doing. (29) If these men die the death of all mankind, or if they suffer the fate of all mankind, then the Lord has not sent me. (30) But if the Lord brings about an entirely new thing and the ground opens its mouth and swallows them with everything that is theirs, and they descend alive into Sheol, then you will know that these men have been disrespectful to the Lord."

(31) And as he finished speaking all these words, the ground that was under them split open; (32) and the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them, their households, and all the people who belonged to Korah with all their possessions. (33) So they and all that belonged to them went down alive to Sheol; and the earth closed over them, and they perished from the midst of the assembly. (34) Then all Israel who were around them fled at their outcry, for they said, "The earth might swallow us!"

YAHWEH:

And where is Hell right now?

SEERSGATE:

Hell is in the heart of the earth.

For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

—Matthew 12:40 NKJV

YAHWEH:

Is Hell the same as the lake of fire?

SEERSGATE:

No. Death and Hell will be thrown into the lake of fire.

(11) Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled, and no place was found for them. (12) And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds. (13) And the sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades gave up the dead who were in them; and they were judged, each one of them according to their deeds. (14) Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. (15) And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

—Revelation 20:11-15 NASB

YAHWEH:

Would Yahweh torment an object, or a spirit?

(11)

Woe (judgment is coming) to those who rise early in the morning to pursue
intoxicating drink,

Who stay up late in the night till wine inflames them!

(12)

They have lyre and harp, tambourine and flute, and wine at their feasts;
But they do not regard nor even pay attention to the deeds of the Lord,
Nor do they consider the work of His hands.

(13)

Therefore My people go into exile because they lack knowledge [of God];
And their honorable men are famished,
And their common people are parched with thirst.

(14)

Therefore Sheol (the realm of the dead) has increased its appetite and
opened its mouth beyond measure;
And Jerusalem's splendor, her multitude, her [boisterous] uproar and her
[drunken] revelers descend into it.

(15)

So the common man will be bowed down and the man of importance
degraded,
And the eyes of the proud (arrogant) will be degraded.

(16)

But the Lord of hosts will be exalted in justice,
And God, the Holy One, will show Himself holy in righteousness [through
His righteous judgments].

(17)

Then the lambs will graze [among the ruins] as in their own pasture,
And strangers will eat in the desolate places of the [exiled] wealthy.

—Isaiah 5:11-17 AMP

SEERSGATE:

- **Death and Hell:**

(14) Then Death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:14 NASB)

- **Anyone's name not found in the book of life:**

(15) And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire. (Revelation 20:15 NASB)

- **Specifically mentioned, the devil (Satan), the beast, and the false prophet:**

(10) And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. (Revelation 20:10 NASB)

YAHWEH:

Can you kill an object?

SEERSGATE:

No. The lake of fire is the second death (Revelation 20:14). Objects cannot die or enter torment. Death and Hell are spirits.
