Here, we will discuss the danger of sending people out without giving them an accurate understanding of the dangers they will face.

I recently watched a movie about people who crave a unique trait that keeps them youthful. They relied on others to train them. And in their search for a way to extend their way of life, they failed to see the dangers that could arise from that pursuit.

Going into any new territory can trigger battles, prepared or not. People see how a person can have a calling to a Kingdom office work, and they will send them off with a laying on of hands and a farewell prayer. But here is the danger: what if sent-off ones have no firm grounding to understand the future trials and spiritual warfare ahead?

So, what did the movie characters do? They bribed their way into greater danger by taking unsafe shortcuts. The goal, or the title, is the most desired way for those who skip training or learn spiritual awareness of what is ahead. The rewards of prestige, wealth, and what others cannot get tend to fuel the urge to move forward without learning the dangers and risks.

And so, people pay for spiritual promotion through special favors, by joining clubs, or by taking a class. They pay for the end goal and take on the dangers of engagement, yet they choose to refrain from learning about the enemy or preparing by learning their weaknesses and formulating battle strategies.

Sending someone to a new territory without telling them of the territorial climate leaves them unprepared. The sent-off people say, "Let's go claim this land for Yahweh," yet they do not understand that entering another territory involves battle. And when a person enters a land to claim it for Yahweh, they must yield to spiritual protocols. Kingdom order must lead, and the people who claim Yahweh is on their side must have spiritual licenses and protection, knowing they are to be in that land at that time.

Even out-of-order timing can activate demonic battles.

To release a person means to leave them equipped with a certain level of delegated governing authority. To release that person means to give them a new governing order under another land, a transfer of settling.

When people give their church members a way to leave and enter a new land, there must be a transitional spiritual covering until they settle. Without that way of governing protection in Yahweh, that transferred soul will enter the enemy's nest, baby chicks waddling around without a "mama," while a snake is lurking to steal, kill, and destroy.
