

DO YOU ACTUALLY UNDERSTAND THE RAPTURE?

SEERSGATE LEADS IT:

Many Christians believe the rapture is real, but they do not take a moment to consider the level of Yahweh's power that is needed. Have a new look: Can you picture or imagine a person's limb growing out right in front of you? Can you see an organ regrown? What about cancers and other sicknesses? Can you see that these are minor healings compared to raising the dead?

Many people say they can raise the dead, but they do not provide adequate actual proof. When King Jesus walked the earth, He did not have social media. He did not have the avenues of television, but the word of His work spread all over the neighborhoods and nearby towns. People flocked to hear from the wisdom of King Jesus and see His power.

The people had proof of what He said, yet many still refused to believe in Him. Even with the Son of God in their company, they could not embrace Him because they could not believe He was the Messiah, spoken of by the prophets. King Jesus gave answers to the people that embraced the Kingdom of God yet did not usurp the governing order at that time.

(15) Then the Pharisees went and plotted how to entangle Him in His words.

(16) And they sent their disciples to Him, along with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that You are true and teach the way of God truthfully, and You do not care about anyone's opinion, for You are not swayed by appearances. (17) Tell us, then, what You think. Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?" (18) But Jesus, aware of their malice, said, "Why put Me

to the test, you hypocrites? (19) Show Me the coin for the tax." And they brought Him a denarius. (20) And Jesus said to them, "Whose likeness and inscription is this?" (21) They said, "Caesar's." Then He said to them, "Therefore render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." (22) When they heard it, they marveled. And they left Him and went away.

SEERSGATE CONTINUES:

But does Yahweh also mark His people? But will He now mark those who are His?

To separate the one who is dead: what organization or church gathering can locate every deceased person? Who can pick up ashes scattered all over the earth? Who can give a branding within, sealing humans in the power of the Great Holy Spirit but Yahweh?

What would it take to raise a dead person? Yahweh gave me an understanding that there is virtually no way a human can raise a dead person in their own human strength. People fear the idea of raising a dead person because today's culture sheds a negative view on any dead raising. We're not talking about a person who died within a few moments. We are talking about those who have been dead for days, with some entering an advanced decayed state. Do you know that to raise that dead person, you have to address them?

(38) Then Jesus, deeply moved again, came to the tomb. It was a cave, and a stone lay against it. (39) Jesus said, "Take away the stone." Martha, the sister of the dead man, said to Him, "Lord, by this time there will be an odor, for he has been dead four days." (40) Jesus said to her, "Did I not tell you that if you believed you would see the glory of God?" (41) So they took away the stone. And Jesus lifted up His eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. (42) I knew that You always hear Me, but I

said this on account of the people standing around, that they may believe that You sent Me.” (43) When He had said these things, He cried out with a loud voice, “Lazarus, come out.” (44) The man who had died came out, his hands and feet bound with linen strips, and his face wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, “Unbind him, and let him go.”

SEERSGATE CONTINUES:

Jesus is definitely not praying to Himself here; He prayed to the Father and then called Lazarus to come forward by name. Yahweh taught me to understand that when raising the dead, you deal directly with that dead person. That decree goes directly to that dead person. Yahweh says to pray to Him, and He will bring real Life into that person.

But there is a powerful note to consider: There must be a disruption in the death phase within that person. The way death governs must be disrupted, and that is where Yahweh says, “There will be an overruling of death within that person so that I can give a new order and bring them into living ways even before the spoken resurrections of Revelation.”

ABOUT JESUS—THE GOD-MAN

What would it take to prove *a* God is real? Can you kill a real God? No. Can you wound Him? But then they say, “King Jesus is God, but He was killed.” Yes, Jesus is God, and He was killed. But He yielded His way, but was never destroyed (never fully removed from the earth). The hypostatic union is in effect (King Jesus took on a human nature yet remained fully God).

KING JESUS IS one Person with two distinct natures: God and man (Colossians 2:9-10). King Jesus is both God and man, has always been God, but did not become a human being until He was conceived in Mary.

RECAP:

- **GOD:** King Jesus always existed. Yes, His divine nature always did.
- **man:** The physical person of King Jesus did not exist until the incarnation (in Mary's womb, about 2000 years ago).
- These two natures (humanity and divinity) in King Jesus do not mix; they are separate natures in one Person.

King Jesus, the second Person of the Godhead, took on human flesh (incarnation) in the womb of Mary.

While on Earth, Jesus sometimes operated in a limited way, but He never lost or removed His deity. For example, while on Earth, King Jesus sometimes got tired or needed to sleep, showing His "man" nature. And King Jesus also showed His "God" nature in His declaration as I AM (John 8:58) and in His control over nature, for example (Matthew 14:22-33).

And only Yahweh is I AM (Exodus 3:14). For those who are Christians, Yahweh is our God. So, when people say King Jesus walked the earth as only a man, they fail to see that King Jesus taking on human flesh did not remove His deity. He chose not to display it every moment, yet He still moved in His earthly ministry as the One True God—the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6).

If you can believe what the Bible says on the rapture, it should not be harder to embrace that in the Great Holy Spirit's will of giving gifts, Yahweh can heal, deliver, and set free humans whenever He wants to. Can this same God bring a claiming of the humans in His

Kingdom and merge them with their spirit? Can Yahweh look at your dead plan and say to your spirit, "Come out of the grave"? But what is needed? Resurrection power.

There is a process to the rapture. I share those training notes in a released notebook. But I want you to think of this Great God who can hold all of creation with the power of His word and stop trying to make Him do what we feel is better. I also have to watch that trait and learn to ask Him for His help (and not give my counsel).

If you can picture a fleshly corpse coming out of the earth through dirt and coffin boxes and traveling up into the air to be with Yahweh, will there be the possibility of waiting on Him, taking our cares to Him, and truly seeing that you are important to Him? But are you His?
